(A)(3) Arrests by OSPD on OUSD School Sites for School Related Offenses

- **04SEP19- Street Academy Student,14, Female, Black was arrested for Possession of Weapon, Minor in Possession of Handgun- CARRY CONCEALED WEAPON ON PERSON, HAVE LOADED FIREARM AT PUBLIC/ETC SCHOOL, and PROHIBIT AMMUNITION ON SCHOOL GROUNDS EXCEPT LE**
- On 04SEPT19 at approximately 1138 hours, a staff member reported that her cell phone was missing out of the classroom. Staff members gathered the students who were inside the classroom. The RP stated that staff members began to search students and their backpacks for the missing cell phone. The RP stated that Principal searched the backpack of Female student and located a handgun at the bottom of her backpack. The RP then notified police of the incident. Student was arrested for the above violations.
- **03DEC19 Oakland International student, 18, Male ,Hispanic was arrested for RAPE BY FORCE/FEAR/ETC, and ROBBERY - STRONG ARM (HANDS, FISTS, FEET, them ETC.)**
- On 03DEC19 at approximately 0900hrs, school staff reported a student informed she was raped off campus the prior day by another Oakland International student. The student was located on campus and arrested.
- **14NOV19 Castlemont High student, 16, Female, Hispanic was issued a NTA (Notice to Appear) for battery on school grounds - 243.2(a)(1) PC.**
- On 14NOV19 at approximately 1036hrs school staff reported two students were involved in a physical altercation. One student had received an injury to the face. During the course of the investigation it was determined one student was the aggressor . The student was released to the custody of her parent with a NTA (Notice to Appear).
