- Auction
- Ride for a Reason
- Annual Fund, etc

Communication Time:

- Phone calls
- Emails
- Text Messaging
- Social Networking
- Promoting PTA to community

Advocacy Time:

- School Board meetings
- Contacting elected officials

Training Time:

- California State PTA Convention
- Council / District trainings
- Legislation activities/ conference
