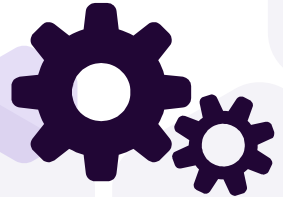

- ◆ You will receive a grade that will appear on your transcript.

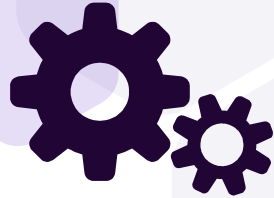

- ◆ Explore internship and employment opportunities with your Work Based Learning Coordinator, Ms. Rubi

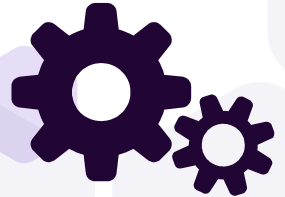
